The Business Ombudsman Council is an independent permanent advisory body of the Cabinet of Ministers, established with the participation of the EBRD, the OECD, leading Ukrainian business associations and the Government. The BOC reviews business complaints concerning malpractice of state bodies. If an entrepreneur is asked for a bribe in "exchange" for a certain service, faces procedural abuse from law enforcers, specific difficulties in receiving a VAT refund or a construction permit, he can ask the Business Ombudsman to consider the situation.


