The Business Ombudsman Council

is an independent permanent advisory body of the Cabinet of Ministers, established with the participation of the EBRD, the OECD, leading Ukrainian business associations and the Government. The BOC reviews business complaints concerning malpractice of state bodies.

For example:

If an entrepreneur is asked for a bribe in «exchange» for a certain service, is suddenly visited by law enforcers, if he faces difficulties in receiving a VAT refund or a construction permit, he can ask the Business Ombudsman to consider the situation.


FOREIGN COMPANIES:RESULTS OF 5 YEARS AT A GLANCE



The VAT worth UAH 30 mn was refunded
